

Draft CUSU Policy on Member–Officer Relations

General Responsibilities of Officers

It is the responsibility of each CUSU Officer:

1. To carry out and to implement CUSU Policy to the best of his or her abilities.
2. To devote an appropriate amount of time towards the carrying out of his or her duties.
3. To attend all CUSU meetings or send apologies, if there is a genuine reason for non-attendance.
4. To endeavour to help other Officers and Ordinary Members in matters related to CUSU, when possible and appropriate.
5. To appropriately hand–over to his or her successor.
6. To be courteous when communicating with other Officers and Ordinary Members.
7. If part–time, to ensure that CUSU responsibilities do not interfere with degree–work.

General Responsibilities of Ordinary Members

It is the responsibility of each member of CUSU:

1. To respect the democratic mandate of CUSU's Officers.
2. To remember the voluntary nature of the work of CUSU's Officers and not to place excessive demands on their time.
3. To be courteous when communicating with the Officers and other Ordinary Members.
