INTRODUCTION

1 *Historical Note:* This case (*Manchester Corporation v Manchester Palace of Varieties Ltd* [1955] 1 All ER 387) was the most recent case for which the British High Court of Chivalry was convened (and the first time it had been convened in about 200 years).
